- Guideline is important to several stakeholders, incl. insurance companies and communities
- Major/serious accidents are hardly published
- Economics: fuel price and feed-in tariff are decisive, not investment
- Emissions: why not separate limits like for biogas to stimulate the technology or should the best technology suppliers survive?
- Emphasizing training, repetitions annually, team of operators
- Fuel storage, conveying, feeding: learn from combustion
- Find balance between economics and security level; issues like ex-zoning, ATEX, IPPC, emission limits, permitting, PED, DoC are also important in this respect

- Challenge on controversial points, how to reach consensus, DoC (client may demand)
- Project team seems to have consensus on CO emissions; BUT we need support of the final Guideline → wider support
- Ex-zoning: not needed if properly designed, zoning 22 ?
- PLC must have uninterrupted supply unit (UPS) ???

- Valuable input during the discussions → draft version 2
- Draft Guideline will become available: on request WORD version
- Case studies → round 2 (all stakeholders)
- Raising awareness was one goal (Suresh)
